FROM THE PASTOR'S



My Dear Parishioners,

As Catholic Christians we continue to celebrate the miracle which is Easter: The Resurrection of Jesus from the Dead. A glance backwards confirms that our parish's Liturgies of Holy Week were prayerful and well attended. On Palm Sunday, we gathered as a faith-filled community to recall Christ's triumphant entry into Jerusalem and to mark the beginning of the holiest week of the liturgical year. Holy Thursday marks the institution of the Eucharist as Jesus gave his disciples a new command/"mandatum" to serve others and to celebrate this meal as a "new covenant" ratified by the sacrifice of his body and blood as our Redeemer. Priests observe this day as our collective Priestly anniversary. Twelve members of our parish came forward and had their right foot washed by me as Jesus did for his apostles at Passover; a gesture of humility. In a procession around the church, I carried the Eucharist to the Repository Tabernacle, providing the opportunity for private prayer throughout the late evening. Good Friday, with the sanctuary stark and empty, we assembled to listen to the reading of the Passion, to bow in reverence before the feet of the Crucifix and to receive Holy Communion. The Stations of the Cross followed later that evening. Table foods for Easter were blessed on Saturday noon. At the Easter Vigil Mass we ignited the Easter fire and christened the new Paschal Candle, from which we lit our own personal candle as Believers! During the Easter Vigil, Michael Salerno and Trang Tram received the sacraments of Baptism, First Eucharist and Confirmation. Kudos to Deacon Joe Lonergan for providing their instruction "OCIA" the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults". The Easter morning Masses were very well attended, with standing room only attendance at the 10am liturgy. The children enjoyed the Easter Egg Hunt, gleefully retrieving over 2800 multicolored plastic eggs filled with candy! . Most of us went on from here to attend family dinners, visit friends, go out for lunch or dinner. We offered the Divine Mercy Holy Hour, last Sunday, which included the veneration of a first class relic of St. Faustina Kowalski and incorporated the recitation of the Rosary, Chaplet of Divine Mercy and Benediction. Next on our Sacrament Schedule are the First Holy Communion Masses during late April and early May. I wish to express my sincere thanks and appreciation to the many individuals and ministry groups who helped make this Lenten and Easter Season so abundantly rich and meaningful for all of us.

They include: Fr. Cal La Verde, Deacon Joe Lonergan, the dedicated Parish Office Staff, Jennifer Salerno & Betty Napoli who produced the Mass broadcast, Mary Doherty, Tom Dunn and the ladies of the Social Sodality who stuffed over 2800 Easter eggs and coordinated the East Egg Hunt on Easter Sunday, Victor Mozdzan responsible for online bulletin, Tom DiPatri, Tony Mazzeo and Dave Reilly who hung the full-length art banners on the sanctuary wall, Choir Director Kim Shea, Kathleen Lewis, Organists Evan Shea and Jeffrey Seals, Members of the Choir, Musicians and Singers, Ushers, Greeters, Liturgical Readers, Extraordinary Ministers of Communion, Adorers of the Blessed Sacrament, acolytes, altar Servers, collection volunteers, candle ministers, catechists and aides, Susan Scott and the housekeeping and maintenance volunteers the "Cleaning Angels", Knights of Columbus, Parish Decorations Team Members who decorated the lobby of the church for Lent and Easter, Tom Salerno and Team for decoration of Holy Thursday Repository and Easter Sanctuary and Altar Flowers, Tom Di Patri, Dave Riley and helpers each and every morning for setting up. Easter continues to be the most dramatic miracle. As "church", we proclaim ourselves believers in Christ's resurrection from the dead. May all of us work to deepen our personal relationship with Jesus, listening to His Word and being more open to trust in the Holy Spirit and to moments of grace. As the weather continues to improve, may the Spring season provide you with opportunities for enjoying the change of season as many of you labor to maintain and enhance your homes and property. May Our Lord bless you and those you love.

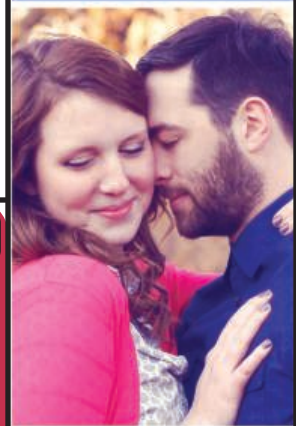
