# NEWS & EVENTS AROUND

## *The Parish*



The Church has always interpreted the selection of the “seven reputable men” in Acts of the Apostles 6:1-6 as marking the origin of the diaconate as a distinct ministry of Christian service. The apostles appointed these men to attend to the needs of the Greek-speaking widows of the early Church at Jerusalem.

We, the members of the Parish of Our Lady of Sorrows, have been blessed to have Deacon Joseph Lonergan exercise his ministry here since arriving in April 2014 and beginning his 10 years of service to the Church and to the good people of our Parish. When he reached the canonical “age of retirement” in 2022, Deacon Joe submitted his letter of retirement to Most Rev. Nelson Perez, Bishop of Philadelphia, the Archdiocese for whom he was ordained to serve. His request was accepted and ratified by the Diocese of Camden. To our great pleasure, Deacon Joe agreed to continue his pastoral work among us through his energetic and faithful commitment to multiple ministries. He was the Coordinator of Parish Liturgy and Ministries, especially when introducing changes to “how we always did this...” in light of Church Liturgy documents and directives. Deacon Joe offered Bible Study twice a year (7 sessions for a particular theme), coordinated the scheduling of Baptisms and together with Fr. Harte, took turns performing Baptisms and offering the pre-Jordan Baptismal sessions for Parents and Godparents. He could be counted on “roughly every third week” to preach a simple and thoughtfully prepared homily at Sunday Mass. He served as the 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Confirmation Class Catechist on Sunday nights for the class of 2022. Deacon Joe arranged for Communion to be brought to the household weekly (Communion Calls) together with Fr. Harte, who also visited the sick and was able to hear Confession and offer the Anointing of the Sick. He coordinated the recruitment & training of Altar Servers and Adult Servers following the COVID pandemic, when most of our youth servers stopped volunteering. He was the Parish Contact for Safe Environment “Virtus” to protect our youth and young adults. He crafted the weekly General Intercessions prayed during Sunday Mass as well as conducting the instruction for Adults who wished to enter the Catholic Church through Baptism or, if already baptized, to make a Profession of Faith during the Easter Vigil Ceremonies. Deacon Joe also presided at many Catholic Funeral Services offered at Funeral Homes, often attending to the cemetery for graveside services, offering prayerful support to grieving families. All these services were done with graciousness even as he and his wife Kathleen maintained a busy schedule of “grandparenting” duties for their children and grandchildren up in Lansdale, PA.

We have been enriched over these years though his faithful witness to the Lord and we wish for him continued health and blessings in abundance.

Deacon Joe made a request that no farewell reception/ gathering be planned to mark his final weekend, and we have honored his wishes (“An Irish Goodbye”). Please take a moment after Mass to express to him your appreciation and best wishes!
