Disciple Maker Index SURVEY



The Disciple Maker Index Survey is Opening this Week!

Our parish is on a journey to know, love, and serve Christ as a parish community. Together we must embrace Christ's vision for missionary discipleship so

our parish can thrive and be a place for others to grow together in faith.

The very first step in this process involves **assessing our greatest strengths and opportunities**, and that is where the **Disciple Maker Index (DMI)** comes in! The DMI is an important survey tool that invites you to reflect on your discipleship journey here at Our Lady of Sorrows parish.

Take the DMI survey: The 10-15 minutes survey can be accessed through an online link from **July 30th through September 3rd**. The survey will ask you to reflect on your own spiritual growth and enable you to provide your perspective on the parish's efforts to help you grow in relationships with Christ.

- Results help leadership prepare for the future.
- A report of the findings will be shared in the late fall.

If you prefer a paper copy, you may pick up your survey starting July 30th after daily and Sunday Masses. The best is to place the completed hard copy in the properly marked box in the rear of the church. Couple of other options: (1) drop it off at the parish office or (2) parish collection basket. Given the number of pages, the latter is the least preferred.

The paper surveys will be located on a table in the back of the church.

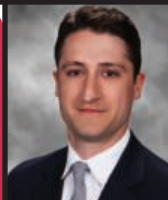
