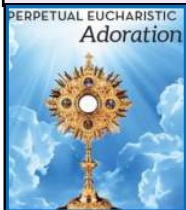

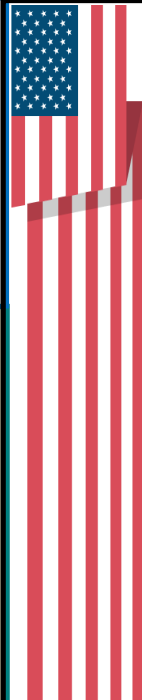


The number of clients served by the Grace Place Pantry has increased to a record high and donations are needed to stock the

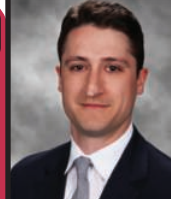
