



OUR NEW COLLECTION SYSTEM

In accordance with Diocesan policy limiting the amount of collections taken at Mass to two, we are beginning a new system for our collections. In addition it will lower our envelope costs and simplify the recording of your offerings, especially since at present both the first and second collections are calculated and accounted as one parish offering fund. We are asking that you combine the amount you would give in the first collection with the amount given in the Building Expenses envelope in the second collection into one total to be given in the first collection. The new offering envelope to be used will reflect this change. There will only be a second collection when there is a Diocesan appeal or a special parish need collection. The new system will begin in February.



Isdory in Tanzania again in an effort to provide a multi-purpose room at one of his churches. 
