PENTECOST SUNDAY

In the Catholic Church, **Pentecost** is the Christian feast that celebrates the coming of the **Holy Spirit upon the Apostles and the Blessed Virgin Mary**, fifty days after Easter and ten days after the Ascension of Jesus Christ. According to the New Testament, especially the Acts of the Apostles (Acts 2), the Apostles were gathered in Jerusalem when the Holy Spirit descended upon them in the form of a mighty wind and tongues of fire. This event gave them courage and spiritual gifts to begin preaching the Gospel publicly.

In Catholic teaching, Pentecost is often called: the **“birthday of the Church”**, because it marks the beginning of the Church’s public mission; the fulfillment of Christ’s promise to send the Holy Spirit.

Key themes of Pentecost in Catholicism include: guidance by the Holy Spirit, unity of the Church, Evangelization, spiritual gifts and holiness.

Liturgically: Pentecost is one of the most important feasts in the Church year. It ends the Easter season.

The liturgical color is **red**, symbolizing the Holy Spirit and fire.

The word “Pentecost” comes from the Greek *pentēkostē*, meaning “fiftieth.”

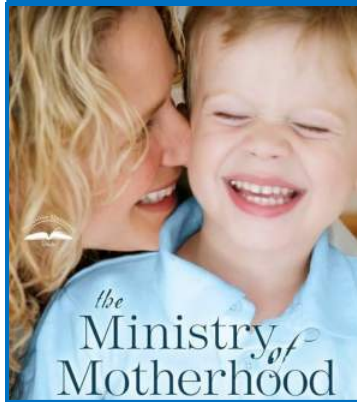
