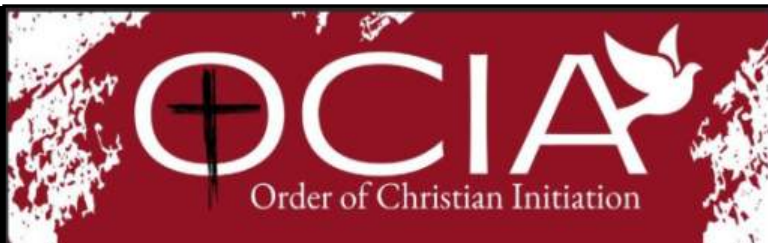

Mission Appeal for the Diocese of Cuddapah, India 2nd Collection: July 18-19

Prayerful greetings from Bishop Saginala Paul Prakash, Bishop of the Diocese of Cuddapah, India. The Diocese of Cuddapah is a mission diocese located in the southern Indian state of Andhra Pradesh. It covers four civil districts—Cuddapah, Chittoor, Annamaiah, and Tirupati—spanning over 31,000 square miles. The total population of the region is approximately five million, of whom about 200,000 are Christians, including 130,000 Catholics. Our diocese is served by 180 dedicated priests, together with religious sisters, brothers, and committed lay leaders who minister in 71 parishes. Through our schools, health clinics, and charitable outreach programs. We strive to bring the love of Christ to those most in need.



Our Mission Challenges

The majority of our Catholic faithful come from poor and marginalized communities. Many are agricultural laborers who earn approximately \$3 per day. The region experiences extreme heat, with temperatures often exceeding 120°F, leading to frequent droughts and economic hardship. Yet, despite these challenges, our people remain steadfast in their faith and devotion to Christ.

How Your Support Helps

Church Construction—Many Catholic villages do not have adequate church buildings. While parishioners generously contribute their labor and sacrifices, financial assistance is needed to construct simple and dignified places of worship where communities can gather to celebrate their faith. **Education for Poor and Marginalized Children.** The Diocese supports more than 2,050 children through schools and boarding homes. Most come from Dalit (formerly known as "untouchable") families and face significant social and economic disadvantages. Special attention is given to educating girls, who are often among the most vulnerable in society. The Diocese also cares for 158 children affected by HIV/AIDS by providing education, medical care, nutrition, counseling, and a safe environment. Many of these children experience rejection and discrimination and would otherwise have little hope for a brighter future. **Prison Ministry and Support for Prisoners' Families** Our priests and volunteers regularly visit prisons to provide spiritual care and encouragement to inmates. We also assist children through scholarships, school supplies, uniforms & other educational support.

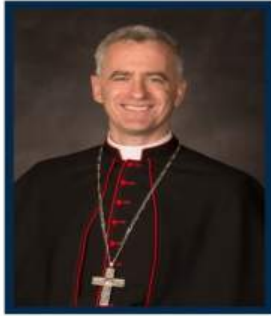
