Amen."

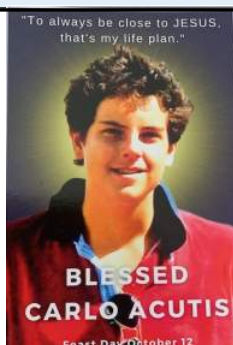

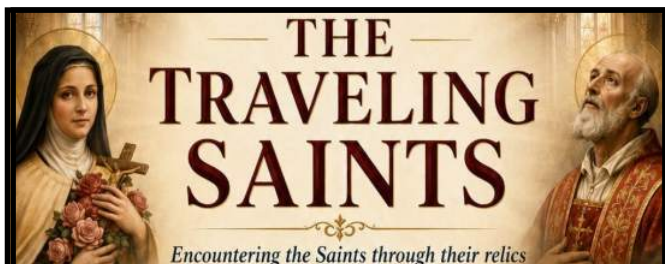


CHARITABLE GIVING TAX INFORMATION

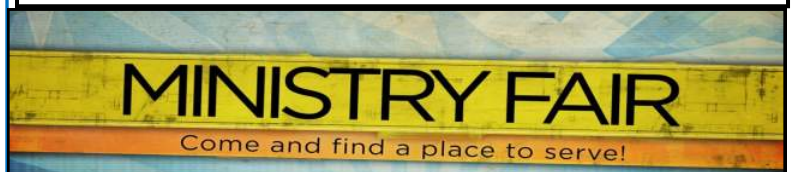
The Requirements
