22nd Sunday of Ordinary Time

The Twenty Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

'The way you think is not God's way'.

None of us finds it easy to hear bad news, whether it is about ourselves or our loved ones. We struggle to take on bad news that suggests all is not well with ourselves or those who are significant for us. We can react to such news in different ways. We might find ourselves not really believing it. We think it must be some mistake. Or we ask the person bringing the bad news to repeat what was said, hoping we might have misheard. We make every effort to deflect the news we really don't want to hear.

We can sympathize with Peter's reaction to the news Jesus imparted to his disciples in today's gospel reading. Peter had just confessed Jesus to be the Christ, the Son of the living God. In response, Jesus had just declared Peter to be the rock on which he would build his church. There was plenty there to celebrate and to thank God for. Yet, it was at that moment of great promise that Jesus began to make it clear to his disciples that when they got to Jerusalem, he would suffer grievously at the hands of the religious authorities and be put to death by the Roman authorities. It was as if a dark, ominous, cloud had suddenly appeared out of nowhere to cast a shadow over all that had gone before.

Peter's reaction to this news was very robust. He took Jesus aside and rebuked him, saying, 'Heaven preserve you, Lord. This must not happen to you'. It was such an understandable reaction. If Jesus was the long awaited Jewish Messiah, the Son of the living God, why would his life end so tragically?

Jesus' reaction to Peter's resistance was even more robust, 'Get behind me, Satan, you are an obstacle in my path'. The rock on which Jesus wanted to build his church had become a stumbling stone on Jesus' path. In the time of Jesus, the word 'Satan' literally meant 'adversary'. Jesus wasn't saying that Peter was evil, but that he had become his adversary. Jesus clearly understood that remaining faithful to the mission God had given him of proclaiming God's love for all and gathering a new kind of community around himself would cost him his life. The only way to avoid the suffering and death that lay ahead would have been to turn his back on the mission God had given him. He identified Peter's resistance as a real temptation, which is why he faced it down so strongly.

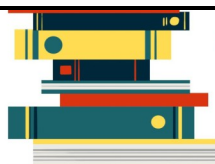

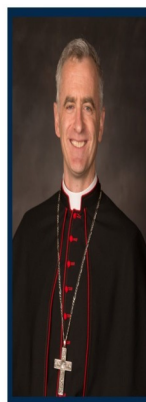

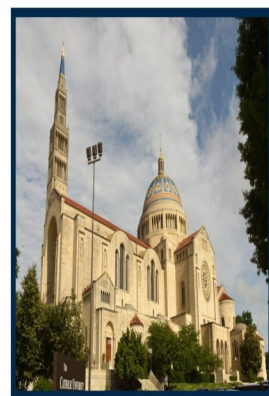
