23rd Sunday of Ordinary Time

This story is about the theme of today's Mass: that Jesus, in grief, confronts life's pain and life's suffering. It's all about the mystery of suffering. And this is the way the story goes, so pay attention! There was once a woman whose happiness was shattered by the loss of her brother. He was a good man, dearly loved, and she was torn by anguish. And she kept asking God why: "Why him, why me, why?" But hearing only silence, she set out in search of an answer. She had not gone far when she came upon an old man sitting all alone on a bench and he was weeping. And

she said to him, "Why are you weeping, old man?" "Because," he said, "I have suffered a great loss. You see, all my life I've been a painter, a painter of lovely pictures, and now, I know not why, I've lost my sight." He, too, was looking for an answer to the question "Why?" The woman invited him to join her, and taking him by the arm, they trudged down the road together.

Soon they were overtaken by a young man walking about aimlessly. He had lost his wife, the source of all his joy. And, even more unfortunately, he did not lose her to death but to another man. He, too, joined in the search of an answer to "Why me? Why?"

Shortly, they came upon a young woman sitting on her front doorstep and she was sobbing into her hands because she had lost her child, her only child. She, too, joined this little company, and nowhere could they find an answer to the question "Why?"

Suddenly, however, they came upon Jesus and each confronted him with their questions. But Jesus was silent and he gave no answer. Instead, he began to weep and through his tears he said, "I bear the burden of a woman who has lost her brother, the burden of a young girl whose baby has died, a painter who has lost his sight, a young man who has lost a love in which he delighted." And as Jesus spoke, the four moved closer. And then they embraced each other. And they grasped Jesus' hands and held him to them. And Jesus spoke again. Jesus said, "My dominion is the dominion over the heart. I cannot prevent pain but only heal it. "How, then, do you do that?" said the woman. And he answered, "Only by sharing it with you."

And, suddenly, he was gone from their sight. Out of pain can come compassion, sharing and selflessness. Learn to love by loving, learn how to heal by healing, and, in the end, in the end, the only thing left is love. We confront suffering with human compassion and with divine love.

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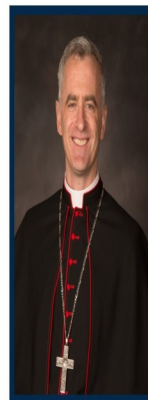

Our Ministries

LITURGY COMMITTEE

Liturgy is the action of God's assembled people. The purpose of this committee is to oversee and help coordinate most of the liturgies, the sacraments, and other services that take place in the Church. It is intended to be representative of all parishioners of the parish in matters pertaining to our celebration of the Sacred Liturgy. The celebrations of the Sacred Liturgy are the heart and soul of the prayer-life of our parish family and the committee's challenge is to create a climate conducive to the worship of Almighty God. The Liturgy Committee is concerned with bringing the parish community and others closer to God through faithful observance of the Church's liturgical norms and guidelines, especially the Mass and other liturgical rites. The Liturgy Committee plans, implements, and evaluates the liturgies (Masses and liturgies) of the seasons of the Church, especially in Advent, Christmas, Lent, Holy Week, and Easter, plus the celebrations of the Sundays of the year and its Solemnities. The committee is also responsible for appropriate decorating of the church during various seasons of the liturgical year. Each of the liturgical seasons has its own flavor and the committee strives to accommodate our celebrations accordingly. It also reviews the liturgical procedures in accordance with the General Instructions of the Roman Missal (GIRM) and pastoral considerations. The role of the liturgy committee is to evaluate liturgical practice, but particularly to serve as a liaison between liturgical celebrations and other related areas of parish life. This committee is also responsible for such things as assessing the needs of the parish community, providing parish retreats, missions, days of recollection for different groups, and so on. Liturgy Committee meets a few times per year typically in preceding certain liturgical seasons. If you feel that you're called to serve on this committee, please consider joining.

ROSARY MINISTRY

The Rosary was given to us by the Blessed Mother. We can enrich our lives and gradually grow deeper in understanding of Jesus through meditation on the mysteries. When we pray the mysteries of the Rosary we are able to encounter the lives of Jesus and Mary and their love for us. The Holy Rosary also builds spiritual strength and focuses on Christian Virtues such as Faith, Hope, Love, Charity, Humility, and Obedience to name a few. At Our Lady of Sorrows Church we pray the rosary 30 minutes before each weekday and weekend masses. Come and experience the power of prayer, one bead at a time!

ORDER OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS

OCIA is the process through which adults learn about the Catholic faith and prepare to become full members of the Catholic Church. Through prayer, study, discussion, and participation in parish life, participants deepen their relationship with Christ while discovering the beliefs, traditions, and teachings of the Catholic Church.

FLOWER & CHURCH DECORATING MINISTRY

The Flower & Church Decorating Ministry helps maintain the beauty and dignity of our church throughout the seasons of the liturgical year. Through flowers, decorations, and caring attention to the altar and sanctuary, we help create a welcoming and prayerful environment for worship.

What We Do

Create, provide, and maintain fresh floral arrangements for the church; Decorate the sanctuary, altar, side altars, and statues with beautiful seasonal flowers; Water flowers and arrangements as needed and remove spent blooms; decorate the altar **at Christmas and Easter**; Maintain a watering schedule and care for seasonal plants throughout the year.; Help keep the church looking beautiful and ready for every liturgical season.

PLAY AND PRAY GROUP is a newly formed ministry created as a welcoming place for young children and their caregivers to play, connect and build friendships. As a place for conversations about life, faith and purpose; we can help our children grow in faith while supporting each other through the ups and downs of parenting. Children ages 4 and under are welcome along with their caregiver. Caregivers must remain with their child. Age appropriate, non-violent toys will be available for the children as well as basic coloring sheets... Out of courtesy to others, children and caregivers are asked not to attend if sick. **PLAY AND PRAY GROUP** will meet on Tuesdays from 4:30-5:30 pm in one of our parish classrooms; weekly from mid-October until mid-May.

YOUTH GROUP MINISTRY

The Youth Group Ministry is a welcoming place for teens to build friendships, ask questions, grow in faith, and make a difference together. 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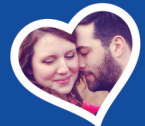
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
